Tubal Ligation

- Hospital operating room procedure
- General anesthesia required
- 30 minutes to 1 hour (dependent on type)
- Ample recovery required
- Significant pain and discomfort
- Sexual activity after incision heals
- 4 times more expensive
- Rarely reversible

Vasectomy

- In-office procedure
- Local anesthesia (no needle)
- 15 minutes
- 24 hour recovery
- Minimal pain
- Sexual activity in 48-72 hours
- 1/4 the cost
- Reversal usually possible

Equally important is the potential for infection. For a hospital operating room procedure, infection rates are typically in the 3% range. For an in-office No Needle/No Scalpel vasectomy the infection rate is less than 0.5%.

For most couples, after they carefully consider the two procedures, a va-

sectomy becomes the clearer, safer and easier choice when your family is complete. Men, there is no need to fear a vasectomy - approximately 500,000 are done in the United States every year.
